GUIDELINES & APPLICATION

The Exemplary Band Award can be earned by a high school in the state of Colorado if the director of the band is a member of the Colorado Bandmasters Association and if the band program has earned a combined 150 points or higher within a single school year.

 A Superior rating <u>must</u> be achieved at a concert, jazz or marching band festival (note: a superior rating in marching band is achieved by placing first in a CBA regional qualifying festival, making the finals at the CBA state championships or placing in the top half of semi-finals at the CBA state marching festival).
